Program Overview

- Training includes 115 hours of lecture/lab/clinical instruction
- Class is held Monday-Friday, 8:30am - 3:00pm for four weeks
- Basic Life Support level of CPR certification
- Open lab hours for skills practice before certification testing and/or to refresh skills once employed
- Individualized job placement and retention services are provided upon completion of the program
- Scholarships are available for some participants, based on financial need

Eligibility and interest criteria:

- Seeking a job in the health care field
- Reads at a 4th/5th plus grade level
- Understands basic math concepts
- Able to lift 50 plus pounds without restriction
- Able to pass a criminal background check
- Has access to reliable transportation
- High School diploma or GED recommended
