Goodwill of Greater Grand Rapids offers Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) training to prepare individuals to pass the CNA exam for the State of Michigan and find a rewarding job in the healthcare industry.





Training

Goodwill's CNA training includes 115 hours of classroom instruction, lab work and clinicals, a healthcare level CPR certification, and open lab hours for skills practice. Individualized job placement and retention services are provided upon completion of the program.

Training is offered part-time and full-time and is held at the Goodwill Employment Center, 3777 Sparks Drive SE, Grand Rapids, MI 49546. The 32-hour clinical portion of training is completed at a long-term care facility in the Greater Grand Rapids area. The training costs \$1,800 per person with several funding options available.

ELIGIBILITY AND INTEREST CRITERIA

- Must pass a criminal background check
 Access to reliable transportation
- Ability to lift 50+ pounds without restriction
 18 years or older prior to first day of class
