



Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) Training Program

Goodwill of Greater Grand Rapids offers Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) training to prepare individuals to pass the CNA exam for the State of Michigan and find a rewarding job in the healthcare industry.



TRAINING

Goodwill's CNA training includes 115 hours of classroom instruction, lab work and clinicals, a healthcare-level CPR certification, and open lab hours for skills practice. Individualized job placement and retention services are provided upon completion of the program.

Training is offered part-time and full-time, and is held at the Goodwill Employment Center, 3777 Sparks Drive SE, Grand Rapids, MI 49546. The 30-hour clinical portion of training is completed at a long-term care facility in the Greater Grand Rapids area. The training costs \$2,000 per person with several funding options available.

ELIGIBILITY AND INTEREST CRITERIA

- Must pass a criminal background check
- Access to reliable transportation
- Ability to lift 50+ pounds without restriction
- 18 years or older prior to first day of class
